- 1st Praise God, our Father and Saviour**
Psalm 106:1 - Praise the Lord. Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good; his love endures forever.

Romans 12:6-8 - We have different gifts ...if it is encouraging, let him encourage...
- 20th Canaan Christian Bookshop**
2 Timothy 3:16-17 - All scripture is God breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the person of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.
- 21st Restored Charity**
Isaiah 54:4 - Do not be afraid; you will not suffer shame. Do not fear disgrace; you will not be humiliated.
- 22nd Tearfund ministry and it's employees**
Ephesians 1:15-16 - For this reason, ever since I heard about your faith in the Lord Jesus and your love for all the saints, I have not stopped giving thanks for you remembering you in my prayers.
- 23rd Rowena Cross and Esther Ministry**
Proverbs 31:10-31 - A woman of noble character who can find? She is worth far more than rubies...
- 24th Pray for your personal witness and opportunities to share your faith**
Acts 1:8 - But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.

25th The Big Build Project

Psalm 127:1 - Unless the Lord builds the house, the builders labour in vain. Unless the Lord watches over the city, the guards stand watch in vain.

26th Spelthorne Borough Council & Surrey County Council

PASTORAL CARE


